

How do I transfer crypto from Coinbase to another wallet? ~Faster Process~

It is quite easy to transfer crypto in Coinbase to any other wallet and only requires a few steps. To do it, first, open the external wallet, i.e. MetaMask, Trust Wallet, Ledger, or any other exchange and copy the receiving address in the particular cryptocurrency that you are transferring. Make sure that you are copying the address of the right chain (i.e. only Ethereum only to an Ethereum address). The second step is to open Coinbase and navigate to your Assets tab. Button that will transfer the currency you wish to send is the cryptocurrency, and then choose either Send or Send/Receive. Enter the wallet address that you have just copied in the recipient field. Add the money that you wish to transfer and check the network fee charged on the transfer. After verifying their information, proceed by clicking on "Send Now" and Coinbase will send it to the blockchain. With the traffic of the network, it can take a couple of minutes or even an hour to transfer you. You are able to monitor it on your transaction history or a blockchain explorer. Always confirm the addresses - the way of crypto transactions is one way. In case of inappropriate or incompatible address, your money will be lost forever. To add more security, most of the users will initially transmit a small amount of money, and only after that, they transfer bigger sums.
